Sunny Side Market Senior Shopping FAQ

Who qualifies to shop during Senior Shopping hours?

Anyone over the age of 60 years will be able to shop at Sunny Side Market during those designated hours.

Why do you have Senior Shopping hours?

Senior shopping hours will help us better accommodate older shoppers who need extra space and time to get their groceries. These hours allow our neighbors 60 years old or older to enter during quiet times when fewer people are in the Market.

Do I need to provide an I.D.?

We will only ask for an I.D. on a case-by-case basis. We hope you will join us in our efforts to care for the older neighbors in our community.

I shop for someone that is a Senior. Can I shop for them during Senior Shopping hours?

No. We want to create a space for our older neighbors to access the Market with limited wait times and standing. We will encourage only neighbors 60 years old or older to shop at the Market during Senior Shopping Hours.

Can I assist a Senior during Senior Shopping hours?

Yes. We encourage you to help senior shoppers as they get their groceries at the Market. If you need to access the Market for yourself, we ask that you come during our normal shopping hours. We will also have volunteers at the Market who can assist with selecting and carrying groceries if necessary.
